- Respect for Others/Harassment
- BSA does not allow discriminatory practices and is committed to providing an environment in which all individuals are treated with respect.

 physical and can occur on a one-time, repeated, or continuous basis.
 - A person does not have to intend to harass for the behavior to be harassment. Harassment can take many forms but generally involves conduct, comment or display that is insulting, intimidating, humiliating, hurtful, demeaning, belittling malicious, degrading or/can otherwise cause offence, discomfort, or personal humiliation or embarrassment to a person or a group of persons.
- When using social media, (Facebook, Twitter etc), I will respect the rights and confidentiality of
 others; not impersonate or falsely represent another person, not bully, intimidate, abuse, harass
 or threaten others (teammates, opponents, officials etc). I will not post content that is hateful,
 threatening, or incites violence against others, or post content that harms the reputation and
 good standing of BSA or those within its community.
- Failure to abide by any of the code of conduct shall result in a review by the Bedford Soccer Association (BSA)'s disciplinary committee and may result in disciplinary actions from BSA.
